This event is open to purebred Rottweilers properly registered with a recognized kennel club registry (CKC, AKC, FCI, or equivalent). Dogs with docked tails are permitted.

The Rottweiler Club of Canada and the Canadian Kennel Club have granted permission for hosting of this event.

The show will be held outdoors. In the event of inclement weather, the show will be moved indoors to a covered arena with dirt footing.

Spectators are welcome.

The judging assignments will be determined by a random draw on Saturday morning. One judge will officiate the female classes while the other will judge the male classes. The assignments will be reversed the following day

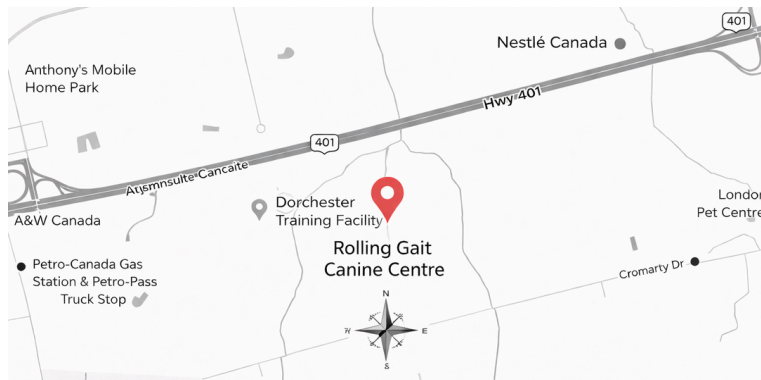

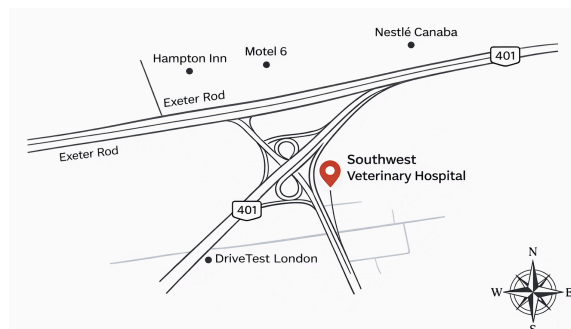

- Open Class : 24 months and older without titles
- Champion Class : Open to Rottweilers holding an official Championship title from a recognized kennel club (CKC, AKC, FCI or equivalent). Sieger or Select awards are not considered championship titles.
- Working Class : Open to Rottweilers that have earned a recognized working title (such as BH, IGP or equivalent) or an official performance title from a recognized kennel club (CKC, AKC, FCI or equivalent).
- Veteran Class : Open to Rottweilers 7 years of age and older, regardless of titles. **Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible.**
- Kennel Group : Minimum of three (3) dogs from the same kennel name. Judged on overall consistency of breed type, structure, temperament and movement. **All dogs must be entered in a regular class.**
- Stud Dog Class : Consists of the stud dog and at least two (up to five) of his offspring. Judged on the sire's ability to produce consistency in breed type, structure, temperament and movement. **All offspring must be entered and exhibited in a regular class.**
- Brood Bitch Class : Consists of the brood bitch and at least two (up to five) of her offspring. Judged on the dam's ability to produce consistency in breed type, structure, temperament and movement. **All offspring must be entered and exhibited in a regular class.**

Note: Winners of the Kennel Group, Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes are not eligible to compete for Sieger / Siegerin.

- **Title Designation**

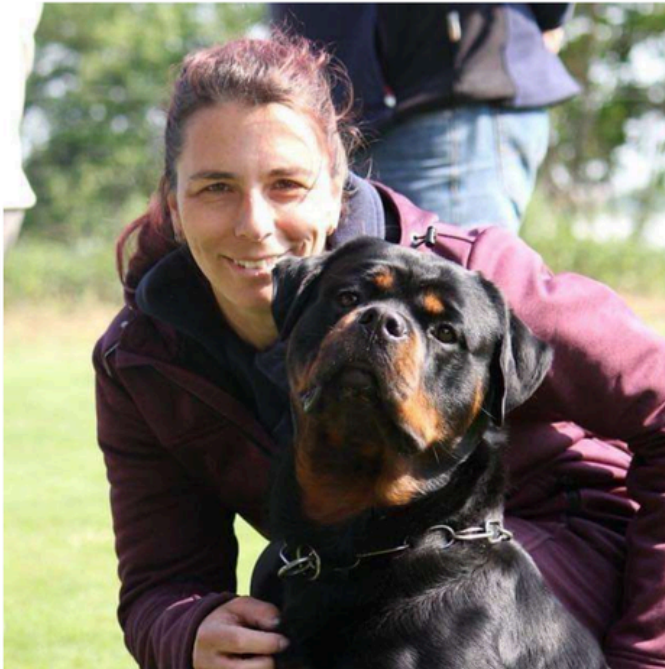
- On Saturday, September 5th, winners will receive the title

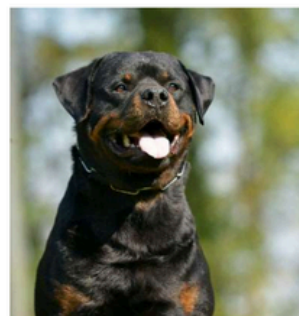
My name is Sandra Reck, I have been married to Michael since 2011 and we have a daughter (born 2012). We live in Germany (Rhineland-Palatinate).

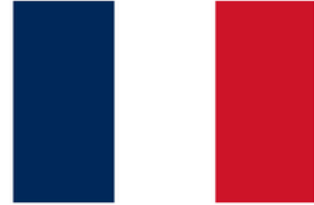

Since 2019 I have been an accepting breeding warden in the ADRK and in September 2022 I was appointed as a special breeding judge in the ADRK.

Hamid Falah, FCI France



My name is Hamid a Falah. I live in France. I have been passionate about purebred dogs for many years and have been breeding Rottweilers since 1999 under my kennel name Vom Falke Koniglich.

Over time, my involvement in the canine world led me to become a judge. I am a specialist judge for the Rottweiler and I am also approved to judge several other breeds, including the Hovawart, Boxer, the Swiss Mountain Dogs (Bernese Mountain Dog, Appenzeller and Entlebucher), as well as the Mastiff and the Bullmastiff.

I am a confirmation judge in France under the authority of the Fédération Cynologique Internationale (FCI) and the Société Centrale Canine. During my career, I have had the honor of being invited to judge in several countries around the world, including Denmark, Spain, Mexico, the United States, New Zealand, and Australia.

In addition to judging in dog shows, I have also been very involved in working dog activities. I worked as an IGP helper and I am also an IGP-FH judge. Training and working with dogs remain an important part of my daily life, and I continue to train and present my own dogs.

I am currently the President of the French Rottweiler Club, which allows me to remain actively involved in promoting and developing the breed that has been my passion for more than twenty-five years.

The event committee reserves the right to make any changes necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event.

Site Rules

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at all times. Failure to do so will result in a fine and may lead to removal from the event grounds.

No crates or exercise pens are permitted around the ring perimeter. Pop-up tents and chairs are permitted, provided they do not obstruct designated double handling areas or the ring entrance and exit.

Walkways and access areas must remain clear at all times. Event officials may remove any equipment placed in restricted areas without notice.

All exhibitors and visitors must maintain the cleanliness of the event grounds. Please keep the premises clean at all times.

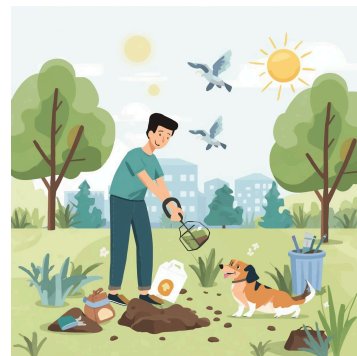
Dogs must be kept under control at all times. Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and may be removed from the premises.

Females in heat are permitted but must be kept under strict control and away from the ring area except when being exhibited. Handlers are expected to act responsibly and with respect toward other exhibitors.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR BEING READY WHEN THEIR CLASS IS CALLED. CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD FOR LATE EXHIBITORS.

Good sportsmanship and respectful behavior toward judges, officials, volunteers, and fellow exhibitors are expected at all times. Any damage to the property or equipment will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.

The event organizers reserve the right to remove any person or dog from the premises for misconduct, non-compliance, or safety concerns.

The venue is located just off **Highway 401**, between the cities of **London** and **Ingersoll**. **London** is approximately **22 km/14 miles West** of the venue. **Ingersoll** is approximately **21 km/13 miles East** of the venue. Both cities offer numerous accommodation options with convenient access to Highway 401.

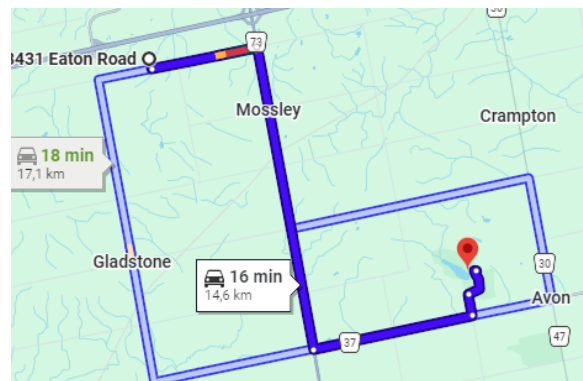

INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITOR GUIDE

United States – Canada (Travel by Land)

This guide is intended for exhibitors traveling with dogs between the United States and Canada for temporary purposes such as dog shows and club events.

This is not considered importation, but all border regulations still apply.

Entry into Canada (From the United States)

Dogs entering Canada for dog shows are considered temporary entry.

Required Documents

1- Vaccination Certificate

- Must be valid at the time of entry
- Must be issued and signed by a licensed veterinarian
- Must include:
 - identification of the dog (breed, age or date of birth, description)
 - date of vaccination
 - validity period

Border Inspection

No veterinary health certificate is generally required for entry by land

Border officers may perform a visual inspection

The dog must appear healthy and free of contagious disease

Purpose of Travel

Handlers may be asked to confirm that the dog is entering

Canada temporarily for an event (dog show, trial, seminar, etc.) Have your entries confirmations ready

Return to the United States (From Canada)

Dogs returning to the United States are subject to regulations from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

Required Documents

- Rabies Vaccination Certificate Must be valid at the time of re-entry
- CDC Dog Import Form (Required) (Must be completed prior to arrival at the border)
- The form is submitted online and is free
- Proof of submission must be available (digital or printed)

☞ **This requirement applies even for temporary travel such as dog shows.**

Important Note

Canada is classified as a low-risk rabies country, which simplifies entry requirements.

No quarantine or special permits are required for short-term travel.

Strongly Recommended Documents

While not always mandatory, exhibitors are strongly advised to carry:

- Dog registration (CKC, AKC or equivalent)
- Pedigree
- Microchip information (if applicable)
- Event entry confirmation
- Recent veterinary health certificate

These documents may assist in facilitating border crossing and verifying the purpose of travel.

General Travel Recommendations

- Carry all documents in both printed and digital format
- Ensure rabies vaccination remains valid for the entire trip
- Keep dogs under control at all times during travel
- Allow extra time at the border

Important Disclaimer

Border regulations may change and may be interpreted at the discretion of border officials.

The True North Rottweiler Klub strongly recommends that all exhibitors verify current requirements with:

Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA)

United States Centers for Disease Control (CDC)

prior to travel.
